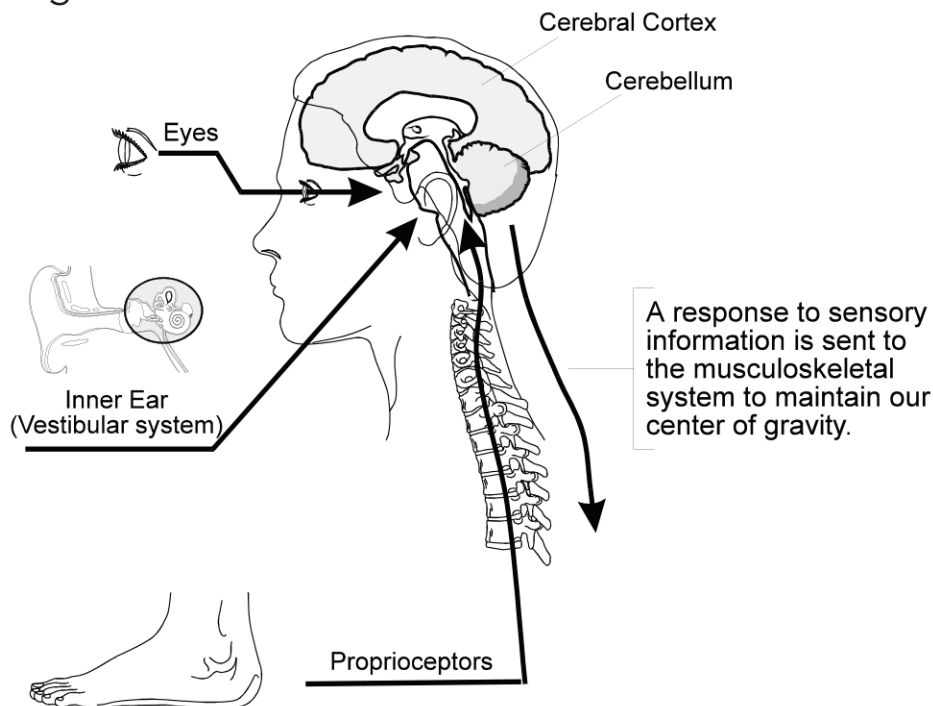


Dysequilibrium

A loss of balance which may be caused by changes from any one or all three of the primary equilibrium sensory systems, or the central relay system in the brain. Symptoms may include a loss of sure footedness, difficulty walking or moving about without touching walls or objects, and trouble changing surfaces, e.g., tile to carpeting.



Treatment Options Include:
